

Directions from Atlanta

Take Interstate 85 heading North. Continue until you cross the South Carolina/Georgia State Line (bridge over lake).

Take exit 1, Hwy. 11. You'll have to get on a short service road to get to the exit once going over the GA/SC bridge. Go past the SC Welcome Center on the service road and then turn RIGHT up the exit ramp. At top of ramp turn LEFT onto Hwy. 11.

Continue on Hwy. 11 for about 13 ½ miles until you get to Hwy. 123. Go OVER Hwy. 123 and take exit ramp IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING on RIGHT. At bottom of ramp turn LEFT onto Hwy. 123. HWY 123 is a divided, 4-lane road and you need to cross the divider before turning left!

Go on Hwy. 123 for about 6 ½ miles (through business section of Seneca). As a visual, you will go up a hill and under 1 overpass after about 5 miles. As you go down the other side, there will be a light and a SPINX gas station on your right. You should start to drift towards the LEFT lane after that light.

A Shell Station is on left. At the top of the hill a left-turn lane develops. Get into that lane and make LEFT at light onto Route 130. (On Fridays, that left turning traffic can back up into the left travel lane before the turn lane).

Go approximately 9 miles to the third set of traffic lights. There is a Wells Fargo Bank on your left just before the 3rd light. Enjoy the lake views to your left along the way – you're almost there!

Turn RIGHT at the third light and stay on 130. Go 2.2 miles past the ReMax, Subway, Citgo Gas and Mini Market and past the golf course on your left. You will go through 2 "S" turns and come to the North and South Entrances to Keowee Key. Take the RIGHT entrance to the guard building. I'll have you cleared. Give them your name and that you are going to Wayne Hobin at 3 Horizon Pointe Lane. Go straight ahead, down the hill for 0.5 miles to a rust colored mail box on the corner of Horizon Pointe. There will be condos on your left. Turn RIGHT into Horizon Pointe (looks like a driveway). My house is straight ahead - dark gray with red windows. Please park to the right in my driveway.
